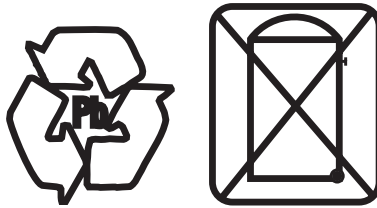


# Recycling Tripp Lite UPS Batteries

### **Determining Replaceable Batteries**

Tripp Lite has designed the batteries in most of its UPS models to be recyclable, and offers a complete line of UPS System Replacement Battery Cartridges (R.B.C.) for these models. ### **Battery Replacement Procedure**

Tripp Lite UPS systems contain no user-serviceable parts. For your safety, make sure that only authorized service personnel perform your battery replacement procedure, and that they shut off and unplug the UPS before doing so. In addition, please observe all proper precautions against electrical shocks and burns. **DO NOT** open the UPS or batteries. **DO NOT** short or bridge the battery terminals with any object. **DO NOT** subject the batteries to fire. Use tools with insulated handles.

### **Battery Recycling Options**

Tripp Lite UPS batteries contain sealed lead acid and must be recycled or disposed of in a safe, non-hazardous and environmentally responsible fashion. To learn about your local battery disposal codes and to locate the nearest battery recycling facility, contact one of the following resources:
