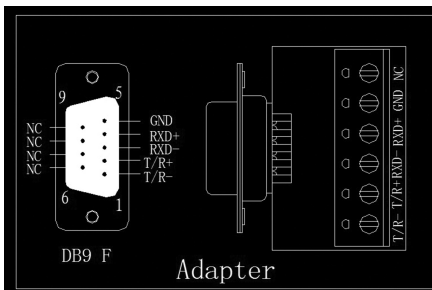

Installation

1. Power on your computer and insert the included CD driver into your computer's CD ROM drive. **Note:** *If your computer does not have a CD Drive, you can download the driver at www.tripplite.com/support.*
2. Launch the driver that corresponds with your product and follow the prompts until installation is complete.
3. Your computer will detect the adapter and assign it a COM port. **Note:** *A direct-wire adapter is included for use, if needed.*
4. To verify your adapter has successfully installed, navigate to your computer's Control Panel and open the Device Manager screen. The adapter will appear in the *Ports* section, with its assigned COM port next to it.
